

Fundraising Policy

- 1. In order to deliver its services, SYHO needs to generate an annual income of approximately £50,000.
- 2. A variety of income sources need to be utilised as follows:
 - i. Approximately 80% to come from bid writing for local, regional and national grants.
 - ii. Approximately 15% to come from weekly donations at workshops, other donations and legacies.
 - iii. Approximately 4% to come from fundraising activities e.g. quizzes, benefit concerts, dances, postal quizzes, tabletop collections, raffles, bucket collections, local/business sponsorship, crowd funding etc.
- iv. Approximately 1% to be earned from charging other organisations for appearances.
- 3. A Sub-group of Trustees will be responsible for the following:
 - i. Fundraising Strategy
 - ii. Communicating with and supporting LOGs
 - iii. Making and co-ordinating bid writing applications
 - iv. Ensuring that all necessary documents are available and up-to-date.
 - v. Maintaining a central record of grant bids and their outcomes.
- 4. Both the Central Organising Group (COG) and Local Organising Groups (LOGs) can do bid writing applications and also organise fundraising activities, following the guidance provided by Trustees.
- 5. All fundraising activities will conform to the relevant legislation.
